1	A contradiction is found between Section I / ITP-Clause 15.1.1, Page 9, stating that only one trainer CV should be submitted per LOT, and Section VII/Page 112, stating that a bidder may nominate more than one trainer for the same LOT.	As amended in: - Section I / ITP-Clause 15.1.1; Page 9. and - Section VII / Sub-Section 4, Page 112.
2	A contradiction is found between Section IV / Form FIN-2 / LOT-11/Page 54, wherein the sum of trainer man-days equaling 16 training days, and Section VII/LOT-11/Page 109 specifying that LOT-11 must provide four (4) on-the-job training sessions, each lasting 5 days, implying an estimated total of twenty (20) days	As amended in: - Section IV / Form FIN-2 / LOT-11/ Module 33.3 / item A33.31 / Page 54; Module 33.4 / item A33.41 / Page 55; and - Section II / ITP 14.1.2, Page 17.
3	Should a single technical proposal document be developed when applying for multiple LOTS, or separate technical proposal document for each targeted LOT?	The Bidder's Technical Proposal is a single, unified document that must be completed and submitted in Form TECH-2 provided in Section III of the RFP Document, page 27, and in accordance with the instructions provided therein. The bidders shall first checkmark the LOTS they are bidding for, in sub-section B. Then, for each marked LOT, the bidders shall provide a preliminary Training Plan, all under subsection C.

6	How will the financial proposals be evaluated against the total estimated budget of 260,000? Can the budget breakdown for each individual LOT be disclosed?	Financial proposals will be evaluated in accordance with Sub-Clause ITP 27.1 of Section I and Section II. For abnormally low financial Proposal, Clause ITP-28.1 of Section I applies. The budget breakdown per LOT is not disclosed.



		It is noted that the financial structure across all LOTs in Form FIN-2 of Section IV of the RFP Document is standard. Differentiating factors affecting price from one LOT to another are: the number of training days per Module, the number of trainees, and international travel expenses for Modules to be delivered abroad (where applicable).
7	With reference to Form TECH-2, the TSP is requested to provide a "Preliminary LOT Training Plan" for each proposed LOT, while Section 3.4 of the TOR sets out a detailed structure for the LOT Training Plan. Kindly clarify whether the full structure in Section 3.4 is required at the proposal stage, or whether it is a post-contract deliverable to be finalized after award. Please also confirm the expected level of detail for the preliminary plan.	Structure and contents of the LOT Training Plan are specified in Section VII / Sub-section 3.3.1 of the RFP Document. Sub-section 3.3.1 specifies how the post-contract deliverable shall be when it is submitted to the Client for approval. Form TECH-2 / Sub-section C requests bidder to <i>provide a preliminary LOT Training Plan to demonstrate the bidder's understanding of the objectives and the expected results as outlined in the Terms of Reference (TOR), and describe the technical approach and methodology the bidder would adopt to implement the required TSP Services.</i> To facilitate bidders in composing their proposed training plan, sub-sections C1 to C4 in Form TECH-2 provide TOR references ([in parentheses] guiding the bidders on easily finding the requested details. <u>In conclusion:</u> the expected level of detail for the preliminary plan is not of course a post-contract deliverable one, however, it is a level that satisfactory serves the purpose of Form TECH-2 / Sub-section C (demonstrate understanding of the objectives and the expected results, technical approach and methodology the bidder would adopt to implement the required TSP Services). To further facilitate bidders' understanding of the LOT Training Plan's level of detail requested in the Technical Proposal, the following rule is added to the RFP: "The length of each LOT Training Plan in the Technical Proposal shall not exceed 3 pages." (see the Amendments to the RFP).
